Watercolor painting supply list:

- Table easel or a stand up easel - which ever you prefer to use. Standing Easels are available at the Wilmington Art Center
- # 12 and #8 Round watercolor brush
- 1 inch Flat watercolor brush
- 2B pencil
- Notebook to take notes
- A plastic or ceramic white mixing tray (Find one that has pockets (wells) around the edge to hold paint with a mixing space in the middle and a cover)
- A plastic container to hold water (large yogurt containers are good or equivalent)
- An 18 x 20 inch (approx.) piece of masonite or drawing board to tape your paper (if you buy block watercolor paper you will not need the masonite)
- 140 lb watercolor paper (you can buy a block of paper 12 x 14 or large single sheets that can be cut into various sizes) good brands are Arches, Fabriano, or Lanaquarelle
- Masking tape
- Paper towels

Be sure to have the following colors:

Winsor Newton professional is a good brand with rich colors and worth the price.
